Whitewater Journey takes both the performers and audience on an adventurous river-ride over foaming rapids and swiftly flowing currents. Midway through the trip, a gentle respite is encountered where the grandeur of the scenery can be appreciated, but soon the river again demands attention until the final destination is safely reached.

To the Director: The suspended cymbal rolls, which are used throughout to depict cresting waves, should not be overly loud at the climax of each crescendo. The general effect needs to be heard but care should be taken to also blend with the rest of the band. Medium-hard felt sticks should be used on the suspended cymbal. If tri-toms are not available, the high, medium and low toms on a drumset may be used if played "gently."
