PROGRAM NOTES

This piece draws its inspiration from “the land down under” and features quotations from the traditional Australian tunes *Waltzing Matilda*, *Bound For South Australia*, and *Advance Australia Fair* as it salutes the spirit, diversity, and proud heritage of the people of Australia.

Inhabited for some 40,000 to 60,000 years before Captain Cook’s arrival in 1770, Australia’s name is derived from the Latin *Terra Australis Incognita* (an unknown land of the South), a name that frequently appeared on medieval maps, even though cartographers of the time had no actual documented knowledge of the continent.

Long known for its striking landscapes and rich ancient culture, modern day Australia consists of six states (New South Wales, Queensland, South Australia, Tasmania, Victoria, and Western Australia) and two mainland territories (Australian Capital Territory and Northern Territory), has a population of more than 23 million people, is the world’s sixth-largest country in terms of square miles, and boasts the world’s twelfth-largest economy.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

In the introductory passage (measures 1–7), the ensemble should strive for a serene, peaceful, and ethereal mood. This will be, of course, in sharp contrast to the rollicking, energetic section that begins at measure 8.

At measure 12, the snare drummer should play very lightly and very softly, and at the extreme outer edge of the drumhead.

In the transitional section spanning measures 52–58, all players should watch carefully, observe all written decrescendos, and support/sustain carefully in order to hold the pitch steady as the dynamic level and tempo drop.

At measure 59, the ensemble should strive for a very expressive effect. The overall style should be very flowing, sustained, and well-supported. All players should concentrate on proper breath support, embouchure, and good quality of sound.

In measures 88–120, the atmosphere should be raucous, exuberant, and quasi “wild” in nature. When sections aren’t playing, they should be clapping on the beat while making all kinds of *director-approved* festive vocal sounds and effects. The cumulative effect should be almost party-like (within reason, of course!).

At measure 126, all players should work for a solid and sustained sound. The overall feel should be triumphant, solid, and powerful.

Finally, in the last passage of the piece (beginning at measure 134), the goal is a forceful, driving, and well-accented conclusion.
